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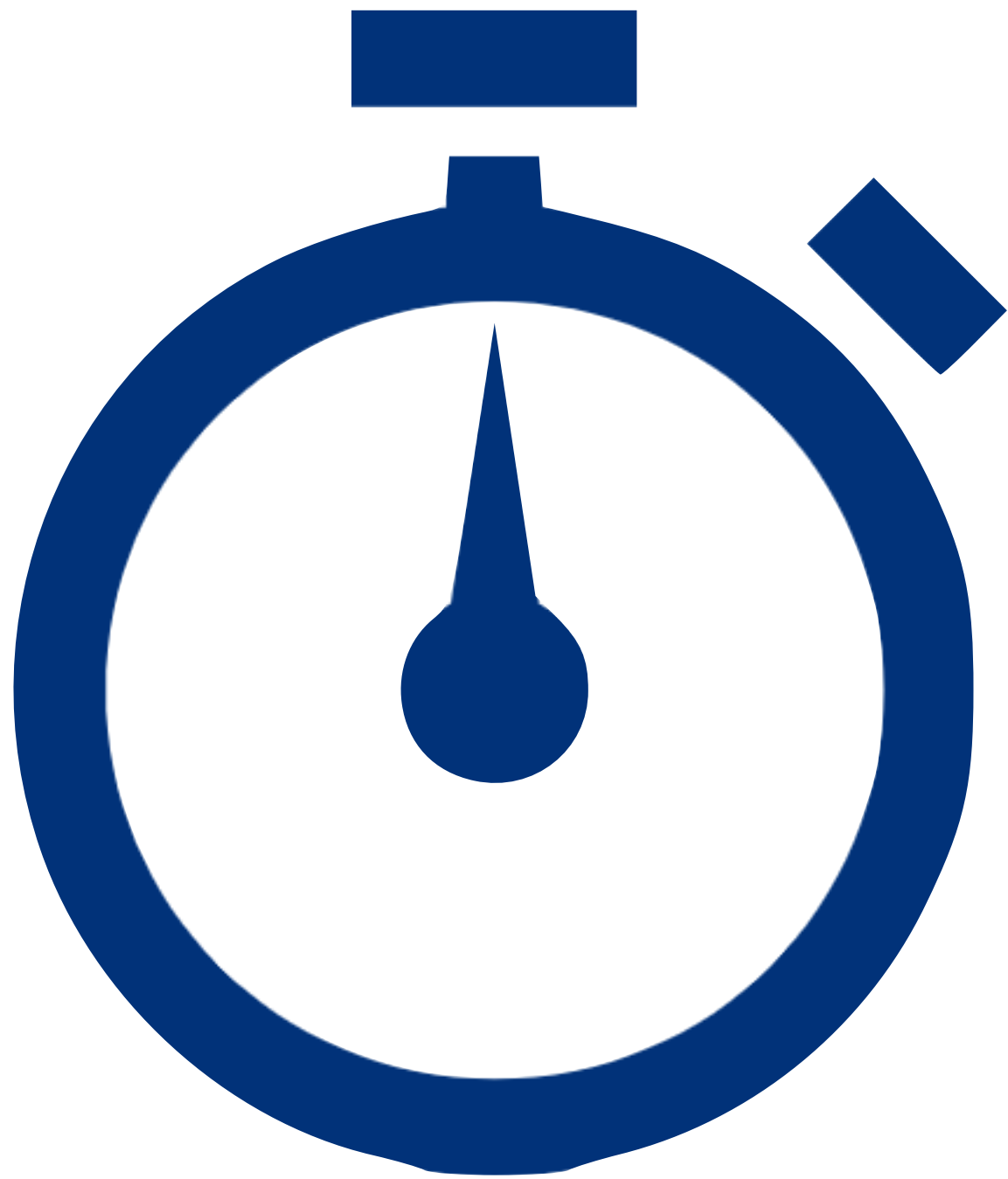

Examples of Activities

- **Tanzania** - feasibility of affordable OPEX
 - 10 schools (Mar2021) → 50 (Q2.2022) → 150 (Q1.2023) → 1500 (2024)
 - UCSAF, MCIT, Vodacom Foundation, Shuledirect
- **Kenya** - private sector collaboration
 - 45 schools Oct2021 → National Framework & GIGAconnect
 - harmonisation with UNICEF and national strategy
- **Ethiopia** - support of MoE initiative
 - pilot 1 school → incorporated by Safaricom in the new 4G network
- **Rwanda** - harmonisation with UNICEF RW
 - Focus on affordability, reduce from 225 USD/month
- **Ghana** - with GUIFI Africa & EU SESA project
 - 2 schools → 30 (Q4.2022)
- **Morocco, South Africa, Malawi, Namibia, Rwanda, Nigeria,**
 - pilot implementations with SESA energy & information project

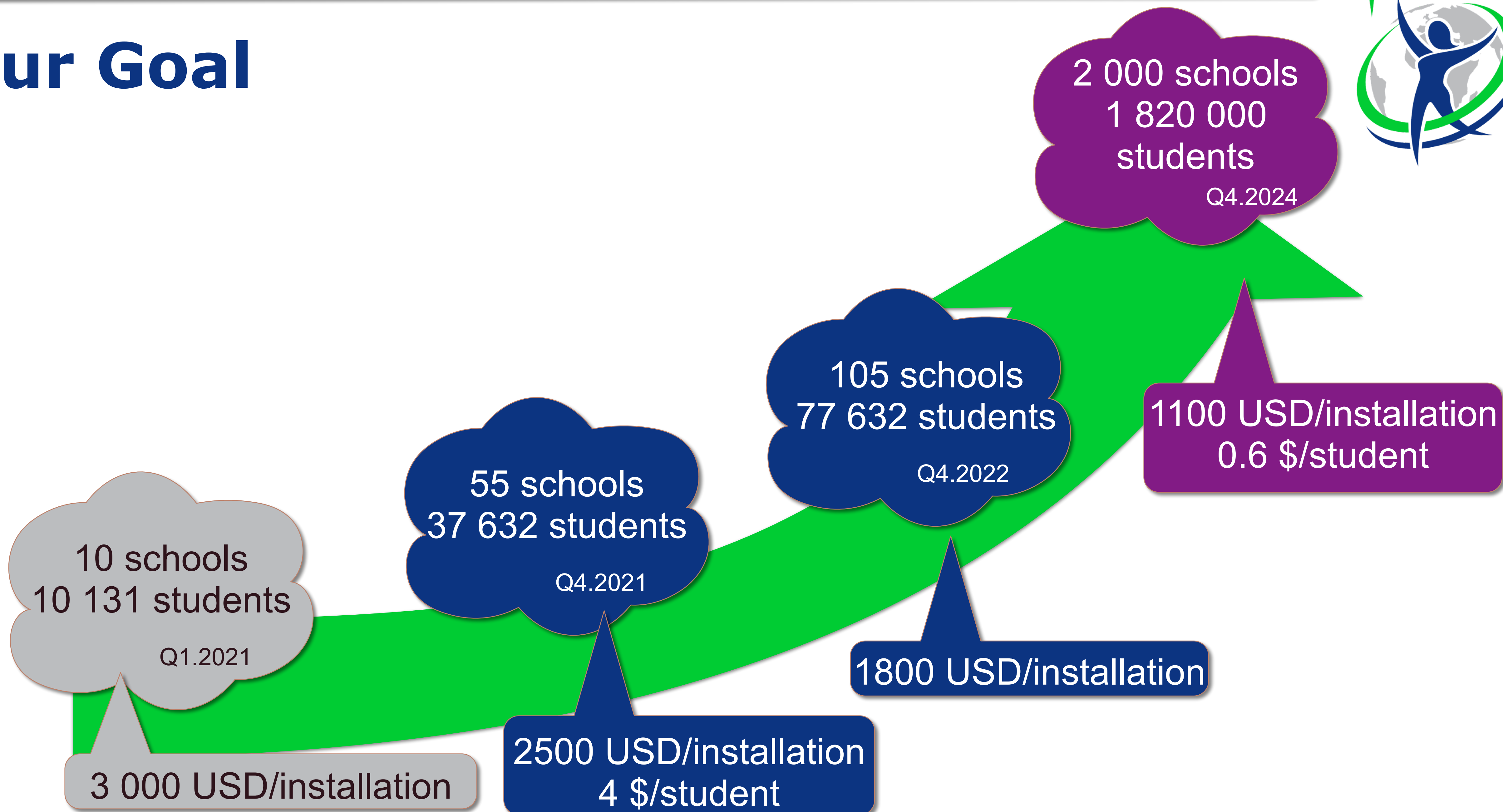

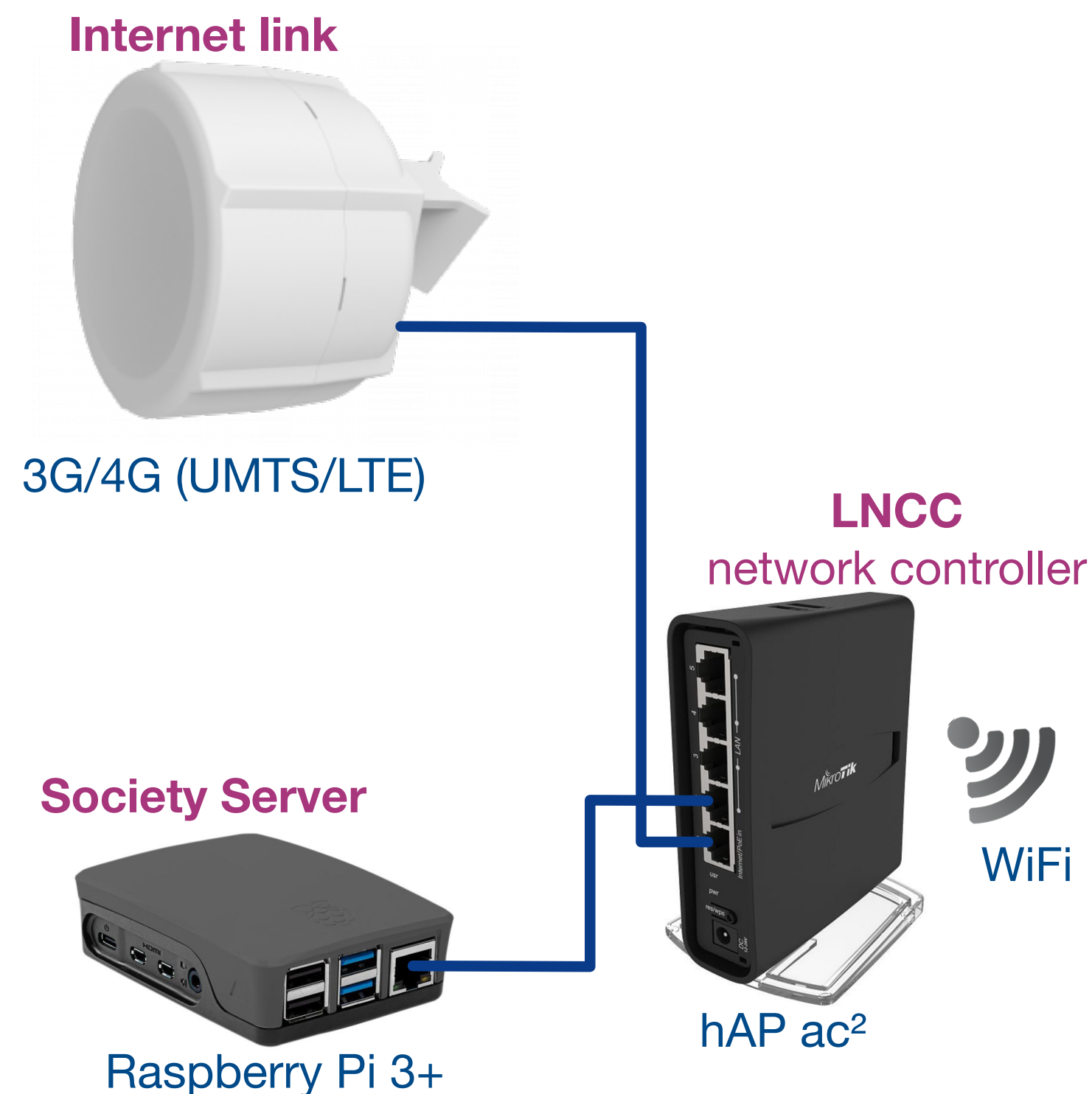

- Affordable solution: OPEX <20 USD/month





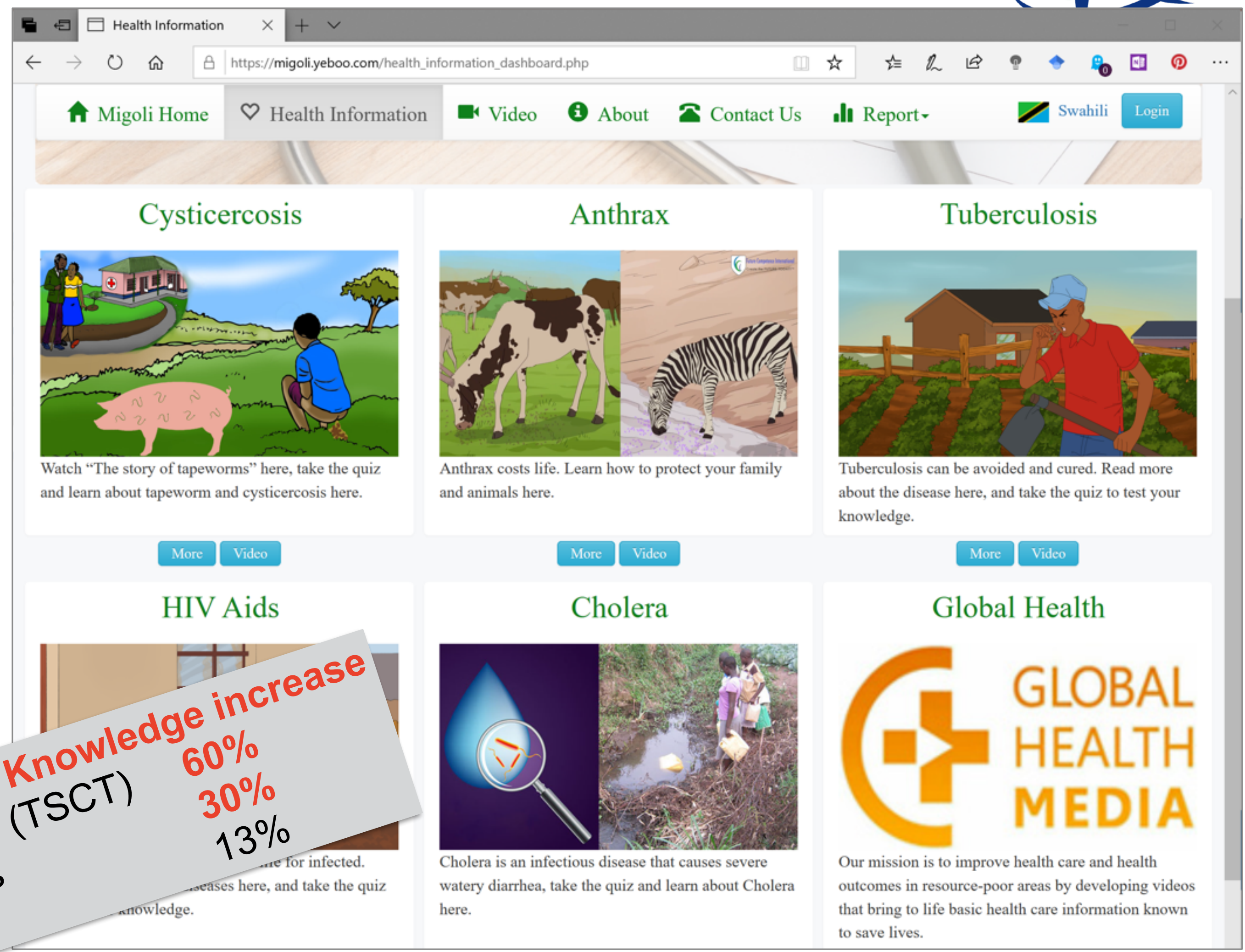

 School server with locally stored information on health care etc.



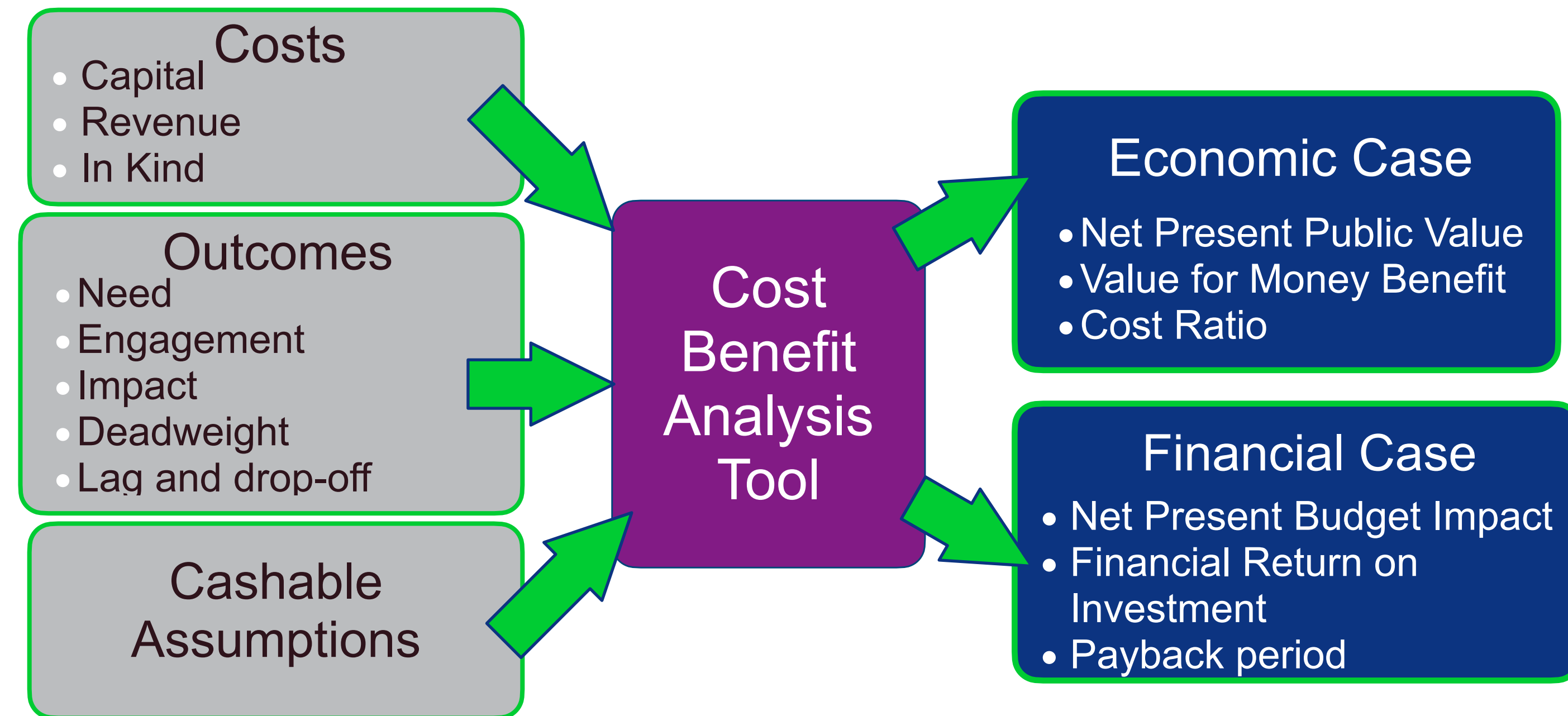
Results in TZ: **Knowledge increase**
