- Rwanda harmonisation with UNICEF RW
- Focus on affordability, reduce from 225 USD/month
- → **Ghana** with GUIFI Africa & EU SESA project
 - \bullet 2 schools → 30 (Q4.2022)
- Morocco, South Africa, Malawi, Namibia, Rwanda, Nigeria,
 - pilot implementations with SESA energy & information project

Example: Health package




