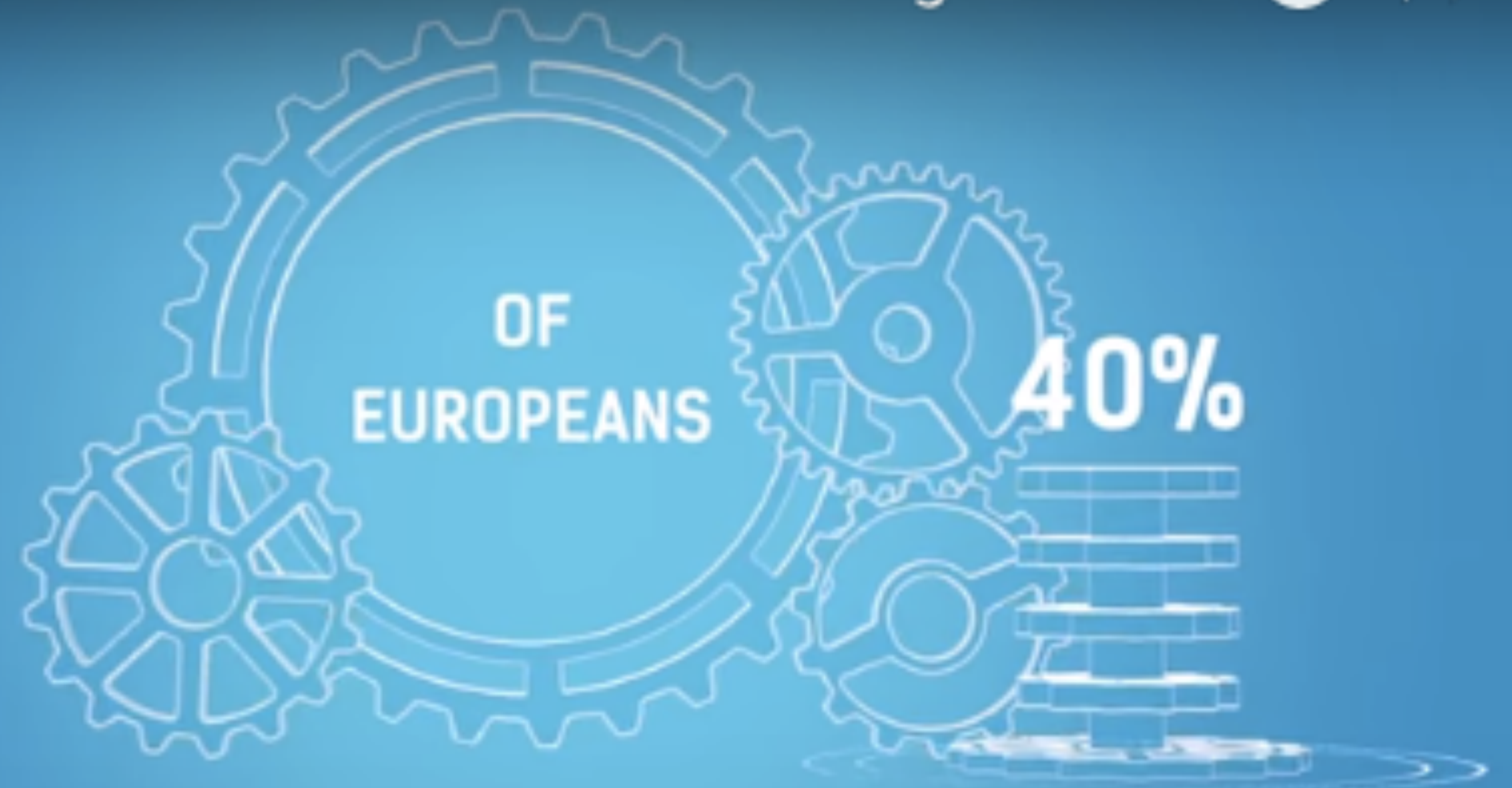

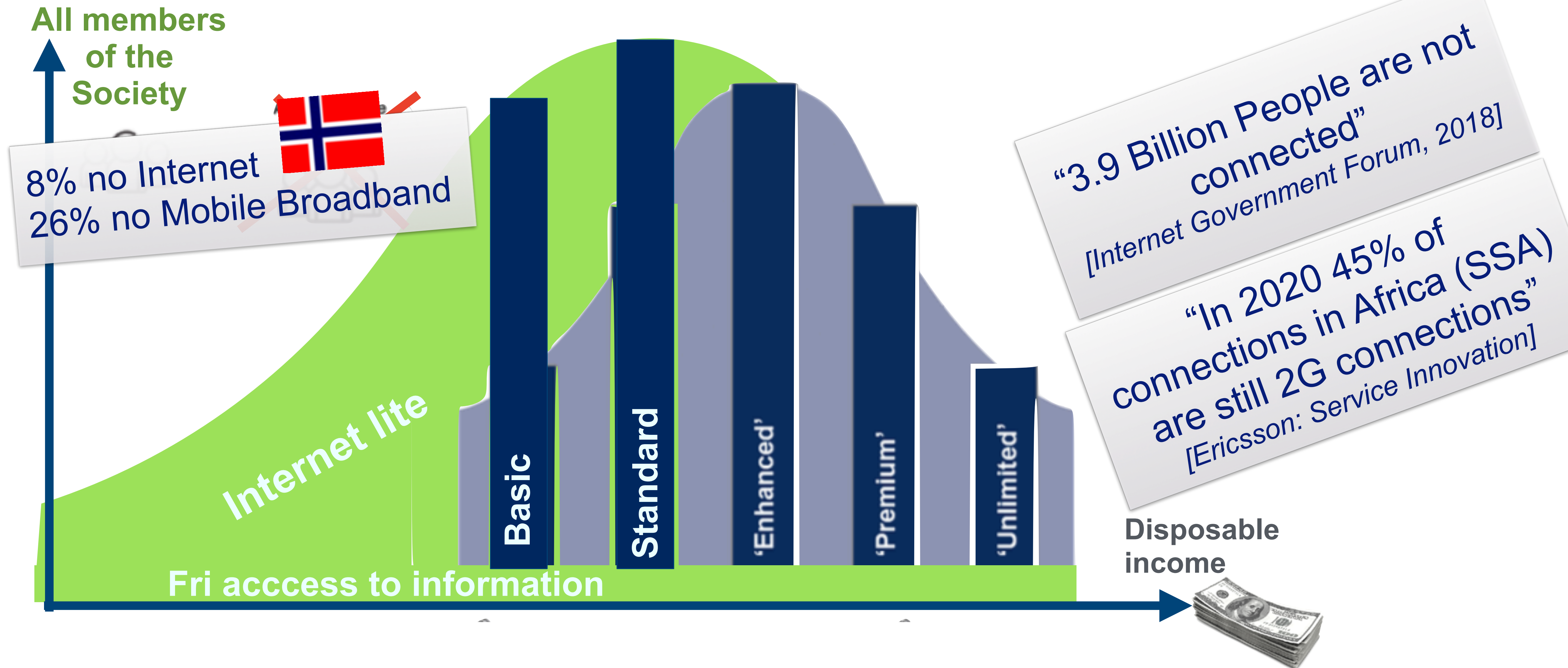

 - ➔ Premium: broadband services
- Ensure **Network Neutrality**
 - ➔ Content type filtering
- **1 premium** pays for **300 free**
 - ➔ “**10 months** of Information, or **10 min** of video”?
