### Reality of the Digital Divide

- → Internet through the mobile network
  - Mobile network is business-driven

- → "Boys have the toys"
  - digital divide in both devices
    - Example Smartphone ownership: 33% male, 16% female (Bangladesh)
  - mobile broadband access

TZ: 640 USD for 4 Mbit/s GH: 600 USD for 5 Mbit/s KE: 600 USD for 10 Mbit/s "every single month"




