


The Business Model Mobile Internet in SSA

- Western World
 - fixed & mobile & work about 100-200 USD/family

17.000 base stations, 🧱 EU: 421.000 towers [Statista]

- Example: Tanzania
 - large distances (3 x size of Norway)
 - expensive access
 - negligible fixed broadband
 - ability to pay: 10-20 USD/family
- Europe vs Africa
 - 6.8% vs 20% of land area
 - 746 million vs 1.3 billion (2018)
 - 112 vs 43 people/km² [Worldbank, Statista]


