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






#5GforAll - Is it that difficult?

- Rural coverage
 - Large cell,
 - Iow OPEX sites (low density) areas)
- **freemium model** for access
 - for information
 - premium for the full web





Reality of the Digital Divide

- "Boys have the toys"
 - digital divide in both devices
 - Example Smartphone ownership: 33% male, 16% female (Bangladesh)
 - mobile broadband access

TZ: 640 USD for 4 Mbit/s TZ: 600 USD for 5 Mbit/s GH: 600 USD for 10 Mbit/s KE: 600 USD for 10 month "every single month"
